DIRECTIONS TO ST. BASIL the GREAT PARISH

From Interstate Highway 80 West take the Tennessee Street Exit once you reach the City of Vallejo. Turn Right on Tennessee Street toward Mare Island. At the second light, turn Right on Tuolumne Street and go two blocks. At the corner of Tuolumne Street and Nebraska, where the Church is located, turn Right on Nebraska and then immediately turn Left into the Church/School Parking lot. The meeting will be held in the School Gym.

LADIES PROGRAM

On Saturday afternoon, a tour has been arranged for the Ladies in attendance at The Vallejo Naval and Historical Museum. The Museum's primary mission is to interpret the history of Vallejo and the adjacent area including the Navy at Mare Island and on San Francisco Bay. The Museum occupies over 25,000 square feet, and this fine old building, constructed in 1927, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Exhibits are maintained in five galleries and include selections from the permanent collection of the Museum, local private collections, traveling exhibitions, and borrowed artifacts from the extensive collection at Mare Island. A working submarine periscope is installed through the roof and gives an excellent view of the City and Mare Island. There is an admission charge for adults of \$3.00 with seniors (60+) and juniors (12-17) charged \$2.00.

MASS

For those who desire to attend Mass on Saturday evening, Mass at St. Basil the Great Church begins at 5:30 p.m., and for those who decide to stay overnight, Masses on Sunday are at 7:30 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 5:30 p.m.
