## DIRECTIONS TO ST. CLARE PARISH

1950 JUNCTION BLVD, ROSEVILLE, CA 95747

- **FROM I-5:**
  - Exit at Hwy 99/70 Northbound (Exit 526) – 1<sup>st</sup> Exit South of Sacramento International Airport
  - Northbound on 99/70 to Riego Road – 2<sup>nd</sup> Traffic Light
  - Eastbound on Riego Road / Baseline Road to 3<sup>rd</sup> Traffic Light (Junction Blvd)
  - St. Clare Church is on your left – NW corner – enter off Junction Blvd.
- **FROM I-80:**
  - Exit at Riverside Blvd (Exit 101)
  - Northbound over freeway 1 block to Cirby Blvd
  - Westbound to Foothills Blvd – the road ends at Foothills
  - Northbound to Baseline Road – 3<sup>rd</sup> Traffic Light
  - Westbound to Junction Blvd
  - St. Clare Church is on your right – NW corner – enter off Junction Blvd.
- **FROM HWY 65:**
  - Exit at Pleasant Grove Blvd (Exit 308)
  - Westbound to Woodcreek Oaks Blvd
  - Southbound to Junction Blvd
  - Turn right at Junction
  - St. Clare Church is on your right – NW corner – just before 2<sup>nd</sup> Traffic Light

It features the finest in amenities including a modern commercial kitchen, professional sound system and computer controlled ventilation.

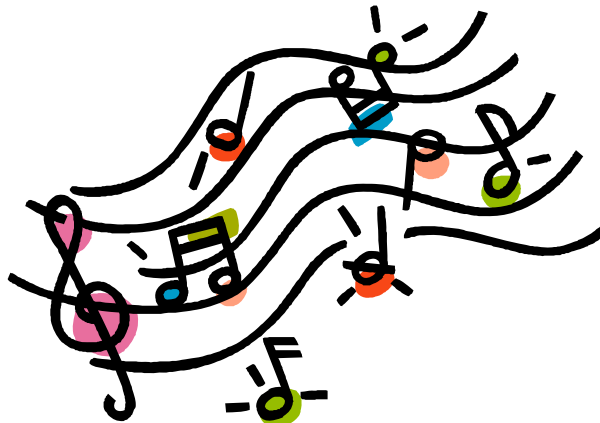

## LADIES PROGRAM

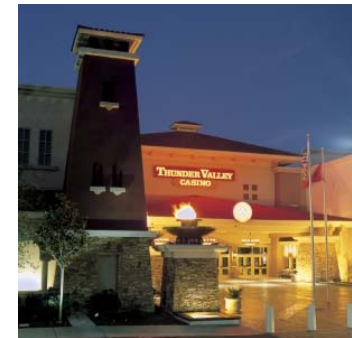
Three options are available to our Lady guests
